DISCUSSION GUIDELINES

In order to support discussion and interaction, the event will have **three parallel sessions per day**. During each session, the researchers **will NOT fully present their research**, but they will only introduce it and then will be guided by the appointed discussant through a conversation. **Discussion on each paper will last about 15-20 minutes** and will include only a short introduction (1-2 minutes) by the author/s followed by conversation with other participants moderated by the discussant. **NO presentation will take place during the discussion sessions**: discussants will lead interactions between the authors and the audience (see file: discussion guidelines). Great opportunities for feedback and feedforward!

Before the event (by **November 30th**), each author or group of authors will share a **video presentation of 7-8 minutes** (see file: video guidelines). These videos will be publicly available in the **RGCS Youtube channel** and will be useful for the discussant to prepare his/her comments and to the audience to decide which sessions to attend.

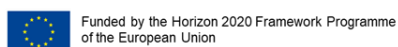
